## **DIRECTOR'S NOTE**

Ladies and Gentlemen,

This play explores the difficulties of the difficult reign of a difficult king. He was at times cruel, contentious, corrupt...a "wicked king" and a curiously elusive king. At the very end of the play as he is dying, he sums himself up, "I am a scribbled form, drawn with a pen."

Some facts: John ascended to the throne in 1199 and he reigned for 17 years. He had two sons and three daughters by his second wife. His oldest son Henry became King Henry III who ascended to the throne in 1216. He reigned for 56 years.

On June 15, 1215, near Windsor, John signed the Magna Carta – the Great Charter. It happened because of the first time in England's history when influential people co-operated together to make a national protest against bad government.

My sincerest thanks to everyone both onstage and backstage who worked so tirelessly to bring this extraordinary Shakespeare history play to our stage. Profound thanks to this amazingly talented group of people who were willing to take on the task of breathing life into these complex characters.




